Book Citation Index (on Web of Science)

Books Citation Index brings together scholarly book, journal, and conference proceedings literature within **Web of Science**, allowing researchers to analyse the citation network between books and the wider world of scholarly research.

Book Citation Index coverage includes:

- **Science and Social Science and Humanities** -- publications back to 2005
- Content comprised of **scholarly books** that present fully referenced

- articles of original research, or reviews of the literature.
- Both multi-authored and single-authored
- Series and non-series
- Encyclopedias, Reference Books generally **not in-**

cluded, though graduate level texts may be considered.

- Full indexing of Books and individually-authored Book Chapters.

Capture of all fundamental bibliographic information as well as **author cited references**.

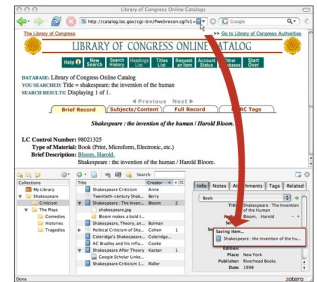

Zotero : free reference/ bibliographic manager

Zotero <www.zotero.org> is a free, open source extension for the Firefox browser, that enables users to collect, manage, and cite research from all types of sources from the browser. It is partly a piece of reference management software, used to manage bibliographies and references when writing essays and articles. On many major research websites such as **digital libraries**, **Google Scholar**, **Google Books**, **Amazon.com**, and even Wikipedia, Zotero detects when a book, article, or other resource is being viewed and with a mouse click finds and saves the full reference information to a local file. If the source is an online article or web page, Zotero can optionally store a local copy of the source. Users can then add notes, tags, and their own metadata through the in-browser interface. Selections of the local reference library data can later be exported as formatted bibliographies.

The program is produced by the Center for History and New Media of George Mason University and is currently available in public beta. It is open and extensible, allowing other users to contribute citation styles and site translators, and more generally for others who are building digital tools for researchers to expand the platform. The name is from Albanian language "to master".

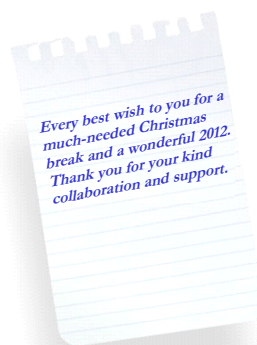
Mendeley <<http://www.mendeley.com/>> is a free reference manager and academic social network that can help you organize your research, collaborate with others online, and discover the latest research .
