




Imaging in Medicine : short-term trial until 30 April 2010

Elsevier have kindly extended the free trial to **Scopus** until 30 April 2010.

As you may not know the **Australian Research Council (ARC)** has recently announced that Scopus will provide citation information for the full Excellence in Research for Australia (**ERA**) initiative in 2010.

Scopus is a multidisciplinary abstract and citation database of peer-reviewed literature and quality web sources with smart tools to track, analyze and visualize research.

In order to take advantage of personalised features in **Scopus**, users can click on the Register link on the top right hand corner of any page.

It is the major competitor product to Thomson Reuters **Web of Science** which QUT Library already subscribes to and also **Google Scholar**.

QUT Library has organized a trial until 9 May 2010 to the **Bentham Science** collection of 93 journal titles via **Bentham Direct**.

These journals contain content relevant for pharmaceutical, biomedical and medical researchers.

- Current Cancer Drug Targets


In addition BENTHAM OPEN publishes over 250

QUT Library has organized a trial until 30 April 2010 to the **Oxford Art Online** collection. **Oxford Art Online** offers:

- The full text of the acclaimed 34-volume The Dictionary of Art plus The Oxford Companion to Western Art.
- Over 45,000 signed articles on every aspect of the visual arts from prehistory to the present day — from Paleolithic cave and rock art to the work of Frida Kahlo and Damien Hirst.
- More than 26 million words covering the fine arts (painting, sculpture, and architecture) and the decorative arts (ceramics, textiles, jewellery, interior design, furniture, glass, metalwork, and more).
- Over 5000 art images and line drawings displayed in the text of articles plus over 40,000 image links from high-quality museum and other art sites.
- More than 21,000 biographies (of artists, architects, patrons, collectors, dealers, theorists, writers, and scholars)
- Extensive coverage of World Art: unparalleled depth of information covering the civilisations and cultures of Africa, South-east Asia, Central Asia, Mongolia, China, India, the Islamic World, Japan, Korea, Europe, North America, South America, Pacific and Aboriginal Australia, Pre-Columbian America, Ancient Egypt, Ancient Greece, Ancient Rome, and the Ancient Near East.
