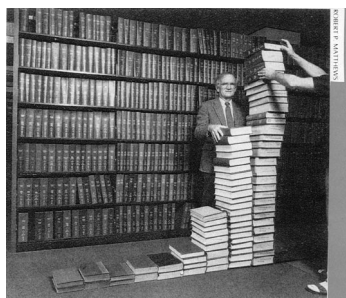
Next year we will add to the collection a large number of new resources and backfiles and I will write more about them once access to them is established in January 2008.

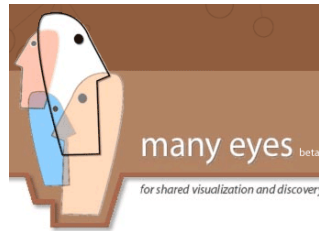

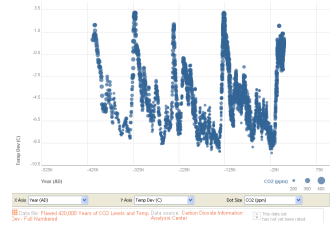
Many Eyes : visualisation software

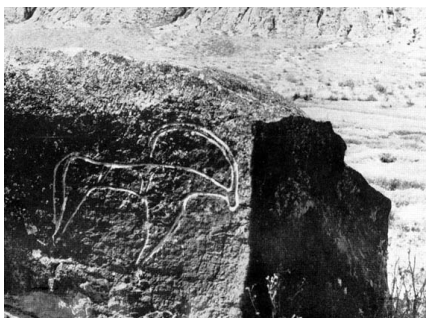
