

Library Snapshot 2024



Learning and teaching

- > **8,083** individual consultations via chat, face to face, phone, video conferencing and email
- > **More than 650** students attended **55** researching and referencing sessions and library tours (face to face and online)
- > Faculty-specific sessions (face to face and online) and online learning resources available for students from each faculty
- > **116,129** views of **168** online help guides for students

On campus

- > **3,594,283** campus library visits (total)—that's an average of around **7,246** visits each day
- > **226,277** after hours visits
- > **210,797** physical resources
