- Support QUT You



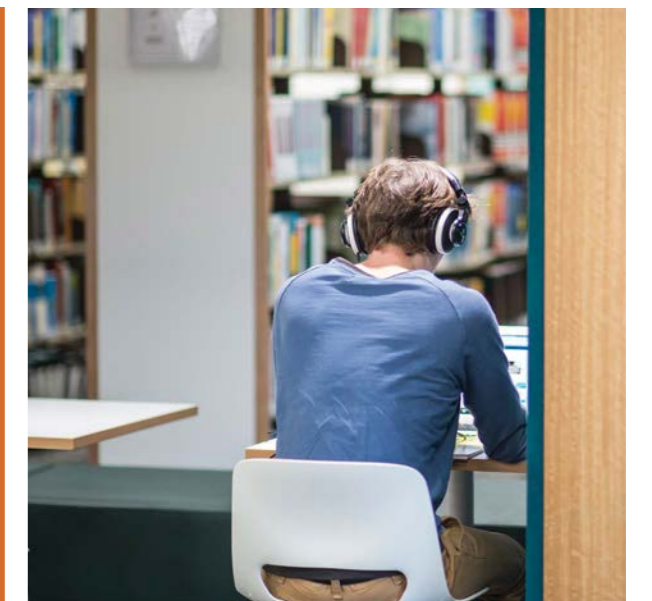
Advance open scholarship
